NOTICE OF RACE

CLASSES: FOLKBÅT, NEPTUNKRYSSARE, J80, CB 66, DRAGON, F-18.
TEAM RACE IN FOLKBÅT BETWEEN FINLAND AND SWEDEN.
OTHER ONE DESIGN CLASSES WITH AT LEAST 8 ENTRIES
MULIHULL ACCORDING TO SRS TABLE 2010 OR SRS CERTIFICATE 2010
WITH A RATING FROM 1,35 TO 2,35.
REGISTERED ON JUNE 21ST .

DATE: JULY 2-5 2010.

1. RULES

1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). For multi hulls the RRS rule 44.2 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe is required.

1.2 Class rules for each class will apply.

1.3 ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Category 5 will apply except for F-18 that has to follow their class safety rules paddle onboard is required.

1.4 Swedish competitors shall follow the licensing rules for advertising as decided by the Swedish Sailing Federation.

1.5 All boats shall in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 display advertising provided by the event organiser.

2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

2.1 Competitors shall comply with ISAF Regulation 19.

2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.

2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

2.4 A minimum of 8 entries in each class is required. Multihull SRS -class mayde sailing on a course with fixed mark.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entry shall be made online at www.ksss.se not later than June 21st 2010.

3.2 The entry shall include the following: name of the regatta, race class, letters, sail no., skippers name, address, telephone no., e-mail and yacht club. Please find the entry form at www.ksss.se

3.3 The entry fee is:

F-18	SEK 1 000

The entry fee is paid online via the entry form, www.ksss.se. Late entry fee after June 21st, 2010.

4. REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

4.1 Registration shall be made at the race office not later than Friday July 2nd 2010, at 22 00 hours.

4.2 Class certificate shall be presented if required by the organising authority prior to racing.

4.3 Measurement checks may be performed.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be handed out upon completion of the registration.

- 13.00 Time for the first warningsignal Team Races Finland-Sweden
- 15.00 Tune up race.
- 21.00 Opening Ceremony.

- 10.00 Time for the first warning signal. After sail with daily first after the races in the Sailor's Lounge.

Sunday July 4th

- 10.00 Time for the first warning signal. After sail with daily first after the races in the Sailor's Lounge.
- 19.00 Regatta dinner.

Monday July 5th

- 10.00 Time for the first warning signal, no warning signal after 15.00 hours.

Prize giving ceremony and after sail as soon as practical after the races.

6.2 Nine races are scheduled.

7.1 RACING AREA

7 The racing areas will be close to Sandhamn.

8. THE COURSE

8.1 Windward-leeward or trapezoid course will be sailed.

9. SCORING

9.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that if three or more W/L races are completed, one W/L will be discarded.

9.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a championship. This regards the Folkbåt, Neptunkryssare and J80 classes

9.3 Three races are scheduled for the Team Race Finland-Sweden. No race will be discarded.

10. PRIZES

10.1 Perpetual trophies. KSSS prizes for each class according to the number of yachts entered in the class: one prize for every five yachts or part of five, until a maximum of eight prizes for each class. Swedish Sailing Federation Championship plaques for the Folkbåt, Neptunkryssare and J80 classes
