1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2.1 The Europa Cup 2024 Sk30 is open for boats:

Measured and certified according to the Swedish square metre rules 1908 – 1925 and subsequent revisions with a valid certificate.

Measured and certified according to iV-30.

All boats must have a valid national measurement certificate.

Boats with a valid Hungarian measurement certificate are allowed to participate if they fulfil the following:

a) The mast must conform to the current Swedish square metre rule with regards to weight measurement (§ 5.6.2)

b) The arrangement for spinnaker halyard must conform to the current Swedish square metre rule.

c) The length of the spinnaker pole must conform to the current Swedish square metre rule

1.2.2 International Swedish Championship with Skärgårdskryssarpokalen is open for A22/Sk22 built under 1925 years rule or later. Boat must have a valid measurement certificate according to Swedish Square Meter Rule. And have a valid expire date through all race days.

a) European participants are welcome with their national certificates.

b) The mast weight and Spinnaker pole length must conform to the current Swedish mast tip weight rule.

- 1.3 All boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.4 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall have a third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 850 000 EUR, or in an equivalent currency.
- 2.2 The event is open class
- 2.3 Every competitor shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority. The person in charge, who is a Swedish citizen, shall have a competitor license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 Boats with ownership or registration in Russia or Belarus, or boats with competitors that are Russian or Belarusian citizens are not allowed to participate in the competition.

3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at the ONB (Official Notice Board) <u>http://www.ksss.se/Sandhamnsregattan_2024</u> not later than 17 June 2024. Late entry is possible up to 2 August 2024 by acceptance of race committee with additional late entry fee of 1 500 SEK.
- 3.2 The entry fee is 3 500 SEK to be paid in Sailarena when making the entry. If the entry is withdrawn not later than 17 June or if the boat's entry is rejected by the organizing authority, the entry fee will be refunded after deduction of an administrative fee of 1 500 SEK.

4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration of the whole crew should be made in Sailarena not later than Wednesday 7 August 12:00.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall no later than Friday 29 July 2024 present digital copies to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar, sent to <u>regatta@ksss.se</u>.

- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee. However, the person in charge may not be changed.

5. Sailing instructions and information

- 5.2 The race committee will when possible and appropriate broadcast information regarding the course, starting times, safety etc. on VHF channel that can be found on the official notice board

7. Format

7.1 A total of 9 races are scheduled.

8. Venue and course

- 8.1 The racing will take place on courses in the vicinity of Sandhamn see enclosed map.
- 8.2 The course will be a windward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions. Approximate time for a race is 70 minutes.

9. Protests and penalties

9.1 RRS T1 will apply.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.
- 10.2 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded.
- 10.3 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 Prizes will be reworded according to the number of entered boats in the class, one prize of each started five boats, not more than eight prizes in each class.
- 11.2 Swedish Sk30 Sailor Club Prize: Laurin Trophy for best Swedish boat European Cup Trophy
- 11.3 Swedish A22 Sailor Club Prizes: Regular Swedish Championship prizes will be given as follow: Skärgårdskryssarpokalen Rotating price mostly. After achieving 3championship victories by the same boat and skipper, price stays permanently to that skipper. Tage Plåts minnespris "The Big Buckle" is a always rotating price annually.
 Debutantpokalen Price for best boat result with a new skipper. Rotating price annually.
 Torsten Helegesons gastpris For great achievements of a crew member during the championship. Rotating price annually.
 Brunelius Pokalen Biggest time marginal victory of one race. Rotationg price annually.

Trickson Pokalen Leader after 3 race finished. Rotating price annually.

- 11.2 SSF:s tävlingsreglemente 2024 chapter 8 will apply.
- 11.3 If the winner of the Swedish championship is a swedish citizen he/she will be invited to sail the competition "Seglingens Mästare".

KSSS Sustainability

- The world's oceans and especially the Baltic Sea are not feeling well. All sailors, officials and visitors to the sea must step forward and protect them. As a regatta organizer KSSS are committed to limit the negative environmental impact of the regatta and expect everyone involved to follow the guidelines below.
 - No marine waste is ok. Keep the trash safe on board so it does not blow in the water. All waste should be disposed in containers ashore and if you find some waste in, or close to, the water please pick it up.
 - Bring your own personal reusable water bottle. If you use sports drinks, bring along a powdered sports drink mix to use in your reusable water bottle.
 - Please refrain from using detergents that can adversely affect water quality.
 - Reduce fuel consumption by turning off your engine when it is safe to do so, anchoring instead of idle, and slowing down the speed.
 - Fill fuel tanks slowly and use absorbent pads to trap drops and spills. Do not overfill the fuel tank. Try to leave the tank 10% empty so that the fuel can expand when the fuel is heated. Make sure your engine is well maintained to avoid oil or fuel leakage.
