

# **Course E - Supplementary Sailings Instructions**

Event: KSSS Olympic Class Regatta

Classes: Int. Moth and Waszp

**Date:** October 7-8, 2017

Organizer: Royal Swedish Yacht Club, KSSS

#### 1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing

Day	Date	The planned time of the warning signal for the first race each day is
Saturday	2017-10-07	Time: 10:55
Sunday	2017-10-08	Time: 09:55

On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:55.

- 1.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
- 1.3 Twelve races are scheduled during the regatta
- 1.4 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 20 minutes to sail.

#### 2. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 2.1 The race office and notice board is located at KSSS clubhouse in Saltsjöbaden.
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole outside Sjövillan.

#### 3. Marks

3.1 The rounding marks are yellow buoys.

The starting and the finishing line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starting vessel and an orange flag buoy. See attachment A. This changes App S 11.1.



3.2 When changing the course, the original mark will be moved. This changes App S 10.1.

#### 4. Time limits

- 4.1 Race Time Limit Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 40 minutes.
- 4.2 Finishing Window Finishing window is 10 minutes.

When the leading boat completes the course and finishes, all boats that cross the finish line within 10 minutes after the leading boat has finished shall be deemed to be finishing irrespective of the number of laps they have completed. Their position in the race will be noted from their finishing order and number of completed laps with those having the most laps being recorded ahead of those with less completed laps. Boats that have only completed 1 lap shall be ranked behind boats that have completed 2 laps. This changes rules 28.1 and A4.

Boats failing to cross the finish line within 10 minutes after the first boat has sailed the course and finished will be scored after those finishing in accordance with above described that completed more laps, according to their position at their last rounding of the leeward mark. If they have not yet rounded the leeward mark, will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

#### 5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

- 5.1 The course is windward-leeward course as described in attachment A. To be sailed in this order: START 1 2 1 FINISH
- 5.2 Class flags Int.Moth and Waszp Flag **K** This changes App S 6.1
- 5.3 The Race committee will not show the course as stated in App S 7.1. This changes App S 7.1.
- 5.4 A boat starting later than 5 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes RRS App A4.2.
- 5.5 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 5.6 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 5.7 Rules for support persons



- a) Support person shall launch, berth and take up his craft (coach boat) as directed by the organizer.
- b) Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk

breaking RRS 41.

c) During the race, a support person shall not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.
