Radial Master - Part of the Euro Master Circuit 2017

Class: Laser Master and Laser Radial Master

1. Time schedule

1.1 Dates of racing

Day	Date	The planned time of the warning signal for the first race each day is
Thursday	August 10	Time: 15:00 (Tune up race)
Friday	August 11	Time: 11:00
Saturday	August 12	Time: 10:00

A maximum of 4 races can be sailed on Friday On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00

- 1.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound at least five minutes before a warning signal is made.
 - 1.3 Six races are scheduled during the regatta, three races scheduled for each of Friday and Saturday. The Race committee can decide that four races are sailed on Friday.
 - 1.4 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 45 minutes to sail.

2. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 2.1 The regatta office is located at Lökholmen Varvet
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the camp area flagpole at Lökholmen.
- 2.3 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board at the website www.ksss.se/sr2017 (and may as a service occasionally also be posted outside the regatta office).

3. Marks

- 3.1 The rounding marks are red inflatable buoys. The start mark is a flag buoy with an orange flag and a mast on the starting vessel with an orange flag (note that this alters the drawings of the course descriptions below).
- 3.2 When changing the course, the original mark will be moved. This changes AppSF 10.1

4. Time limits

- 4.1 Race Time Limit
 - Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 90 minutes.
- 4.2 Finishing Window Finishing window is 20 minutes.

5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

5.2 The course for Laser Radial is Start-1-2-(3s,3b)-2-3b-Mål (Finish)

The course for Laser Standard is Start-1-(4s,4b)-1-2-3b-Mål (Finish)

All marks are to be passed to port, except 3s and 4s which shall be passed to starbord.

- 5.3 The classflag is a white flag with the Laser insignia for the Laser Standard class and a green flag with the Laser insignia for the Laser Radial class.

 This changes AppSF 6.1
- The Race committee will not show the course as stated in AppSF 7.1. This changes AppSF 7.1
- A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes AppSF 4.
- 5.6 The finishing line is between a flag buoy with a blue flag and a mast on the finishing vessel with a blue flag (note that this alters the drawings of the course descriptions below)

This changes AppSF 11.1

5.7 RRS Appendix P will apply.

- 5.8 RRS Appendix T1 will apply.
