Accommodation

There are plenty of accommodation options on Sandhamn including, but not limited to:

Sandhamn Seglarhotell

This is the island's most well-known hotel, famous for its nautical theme and its proximity to the harborit is literally a stone's throw from where the J/70s will be moored a. The hotel offers comfortable rooms, a spa, an outdoor pool, and a restaurant with sea views.

Sands Hotell & Bistro

A charming boutique hotel located on Sandhamn offering a cozy, laid-back atmosphere. The hotel combines modern amenities with a Scandinavian aesthetic: the rooms tend to be minimalist yet comfortable, with some offering views of the picturesque harbor or the surrounding forested landscape.

Missionshuset B&B on Sandhamn is a cozy and charming bed-and-breakfast housed in the historic *Missionshuset* building. This unique accommodation offers guests an opportunity to stay in one of Sandhamn's most iconic buildings, blending history with comfort in a peaceful island setting.

Private Cottages and Cabins

Many sailors opt for renting private cottages or cabins, which often come fully equipped with kitchens and outdoor spaces. Websites like Airbnb and local Swedish rental sites are good places to find these options.

Lökholmen

During the European Championship we will have access to KSSS's Island of Lökholmen where we are able to offer lodging in the accommodation used for the club's sailing camp. More information and availability will be available shortly.

Lökholmen has a marina operated by the Royal Swedish Yacht Club (KSSS), which serves as an overflow for the more crowded Sandhamn harbor. It's a popular spot for sailors to moor their boats during the busy summer season. There is a regular shuttleboat from Lökholmen to Sandhamn

Stay on a Cruising Yacht

We are pressed for landbased accommodation, but with plenty of moorings on both Sandhamn, Lökholmen and Telegrafholmen chartering a boat to stay on is a great option. All three harbors of Sandhamn have access to restrooms and showers, on Lökholmen there is even a Sauna.

Boats can be chartered through for example Skipperi.

Travel

Sandhamn as an island is car free, as such you have to resort to other means of transportation. The boats will be measured on Bullandö, to which you can drive. From Bullandö you can either sail or tow the J/70 to Sandhamn, and the organization will help facilitate this (more information to come) for teams that do not have their own coach boat.

Here are the main options for reaching Sandhamn

By Ferry

Cinderella Boats (Cinderellabåtarna): high-speed ferries that operate regularly during the warmer months (spring to autumn). The trip takes approximately 2 hours.

The ferry departs from Strömkajen or Nybrokajen in central Stockholm, passing through the stunning archipelago on the way to Sandhamn. Tickets can be booked in advance, and schedules vary by season.

Waxholmsbolaget Ferries: Waxholmsbolaget also operates ferries to Sandhamn from Stockholm. These ferries are slightly slower than the Cinderella boats, with the trip taking around 2.5–3 hours depending on the route. The ferry departs from Strömkajen, located next to the Grand Hôtel in central Stockholm.

By Boat Taxi

If you prefer a quicker, more flexible trip, you can also take a boat taxi from one of the closer islands in the archipelago, such as Stavsnäs (which can be reached by car or bus from Stockholm). The boat taxi service allows you to set your schedule and travel time directly to Sandhamn.

By Bus and Boat (Stavsnäs Route)

You can also combine a bus and boat trip if you prefer a shorter boat ride. Take a bus (SL bus) from Slussen in Stockholm to Stavsnäs Vinterhamn. The bus ride takes around 50–55 minutes. From Stavsnäs, take a Waxholmsbolaget ferry to Sandhamn. The ferry ride from Stavsnäs takes around 30–45 minutes, depending on the route.

Travel Tip:

The ferry schedules can vary depending on the season, with more frequent trips during the summer months. It's recommended to check ferry timetables and book tickets in advance during peak periods.

By Private Boat

Some distances in nautical miles from Sandhamn to a few key locations in the Stockholm archipelago:

Sandhamn to Saltsjöbaden: approx. 24-25 nautical miles

Sandhamn to Bullandö: approx. 14–15 nautical miles

Sandhamn to Central Stockholm: 27–29 nautical miles

Sandhamn to Stavsnäs: 7-8 nautical miles
