

Notice of Race

Sandhamnsregattan Classic

Presented by



August 4th - 6th 2022

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including appendix S and the SRS rules (Swedish Rating System).
- 1.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the event site on ONB
- 1.3 World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Appendix B will apply.
- 1.4 A classic yacht with construction limitations that make it impossible to fulfil World Sailing Special Regulation Appendix B, may apply for exemption. Such application shall be received at the KSSS office in Saltsjöbaden no later than the 1st of July, (regatta@ksss.se).
- 1.5 Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.
- 1.6 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.7 A boat racing may be required to carry camera or/and tracking equipment on any given position on board during the race. Such equipment shall be in transmitting mode during the race.
- 1.8 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.9 RRS 40.1 applies at all times while a boat is afloat. However, it does not apply for a keelboat when she is made fast or moored or if the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the Protest committee.

2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be able to show a valid measurement certificate for the boat in conjunction with the application to participate, or <u>if admitted by the race organizers</u>, when registration is made at site.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 2.4 The regatta series is open to Classic Yachts as defined in KSSS´ "Definition of a classic yacht", categories A - E. For the category E, or in any doubt, the Race Committee solely decides if a boat is accepted to enter as a Classic Yacht.
- 2.5 The person responsible onboard shall be a member of a club affiliated to their National Sailing Federation.
- 2.6 Yachts less than 8 meters in length on deck or has an SRS scoring lower than 0,850 are not allowed to race unless approved <u>beforehand</u> by the Race Committee.
- 2.7 The crew shall as a minimum consist of two persons.
- 2.8 By participating in this event competitors grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors, the right to use and show, at any time, at their discretion, any photos or any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete and yacht during the period of the competition without compensation.

3. Entries

- 3.1 Complete entry shall be made not later than July 13rd, 2022, at the ONB website www.ksss.se/Sandhamnsregattan_by_Bluewater2022
- 3.2 Entry Fee:
 - Classic up to 40 ft: 2.500 SEK late entry 2.900 SEK
 - Classic more than 40 ft: 3.000 SEK late entry 3.400 SEK
- 3.3 The fee is paid online when entering. Entry after July 13th is to the higher fee.
- 3.4 The race committee has the right to not allow an entry at any time due to any reason. Reason can be i.a. due to too late incoming application, or due to Covid -19 restrictions. A confirmation of entry after online payment of entry fee according to 3.2 will be made.

4. Registration

4.1 Registration shall be made at regatta office before Thursday August 4th 09:00

Registration can be done after a complete entry is made with crew and boats classification at www.sailarena.com

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 Sailing instructions will be published online at the <u>ONB</u> in the beginning of August. Starting list and starting order will be distributed at the skippers meeting and will also be publish at the <u>ONB</u>

7. Procedure for the races

- 7.1 Three races are planned, one per day.
- 7.2 The boats will be started in two or more starting groups, depending on the number of competitors. This is to reduce the number of boats starting at the same time. The groups will be split depending on the individual SRS scoring. However, all boats compete with each other, and individual sailing times will be recorded. If a group of similar boats or boats of a similar age would like to race against each other, that can be arranged. But the starting sequences and starting order for all boats will be governed by the SRS scoring (or an alternative scoring) within the ordinary starting sequences for the different starting groups.
- 7.3 On one of the scheduled racing days there might be other classic boats involved in the racing, not participating in the Sandhamnsregatta, but competing in a race for hundred years old boats. These boats will have the same starting and finishing lines.

8. Racing area

8.1 The racing will take place on courses in the vicinity of Sandhamn.

9. Courses

9.1 The courses will be distance courses in the vicinity to Sandhamn within the archipelago, but also on the open sea, with a duration of approximately 2 – 5 hours. The actual course for the day will be presented at the daily Skippers meeting.

10. Protests and penalty systems

10.1 KSR Appendix T1 will apply. A penalty after racing will be with 3% increase in sailed time. This changes RRS App T1 b

11. Scoring

11.1 The Low Point System according to RRS Appendix A is valid. KSR A5.3 applies. If only 2 or 1 race can be arranged, both or the one race will be counted.

12. Prizes

12.1 KSSS prizes will be reworded according to the number of entered boats in the class, one prize of each started five boats, not more than eight prizes in each class.

KSSS Sustainability

The Baltic Sea is sensitive to pollution. All sailors, officials and visitors are responsible for the health of our waters. We are committed to limiting the nega-tive environmental impact of the regatta and we expect everyone involved to follow these guidelines bellow!

- Bring your own personal reusable water bottle. If you use sports drinks, bring along a
 powdered sports drink mix to use in your reusable water bottle.
- No plastic bags or disposable plastics are allowed on deck out on the water. Bring only reusable items such as fabric bags and food containers.
- Please refrain from using detergents that can adversely affect water quality.
- Prevent marine waste. Keep the trash safe on board so it does not blow in the water.
 All waste should be disposed of in containers ashore.
- Fill fuel tanks slowly and use absorbent pads to trap drops and spills. Do not overfill the fuel tank. Try to leave the tank 10% empty so that the fuel can ex-pand when the fuel is heated. Make sure your engine is well maintained to avoid oil or fuel leakage.
- Reduce fuel consumption by turning off your engine when it is safe to do so, anchoring instead of idle, and slowing down the speed.
