

Supplementary Sailings Instructions

KSSS Olympic Class Regatta, course area D

Date: 4-5 October 2025

Location: Saltsjöbaden

Classes: IQFoil Youth, Formula Foil

Organizer: Royal Swedish Yacht Club

1. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 1.1 The regatta office is located at KSSS Clubhouse in Saltsjöbaden. The Official Noticeboard is on the web KSSS Olympic Class Regatta 2025.
- 1.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole next to the water close to Sjövillan.
- 1.3 When signal AP is hoisted ashore, replace "1 minute" in RRS with "minimum 20 minutes".
- 1.4 On the water, the race committee communicates with coaches, supporting persons etc on VHF radio channel 71.

2. Time schedule

2.1 Time for the first warning signal

Saturday 5 October 10:55 Sunday 6 October 09:55

- 2.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no start will be made after 15:00
- 2.3 Number of races

12 races are planned for all classes. The number of races to be sailed each day will be decided at the discretion of the Race Committee based on forecasted weather conditions.

2.4 Coach meeting with race officer 09:00, outside the Skota Hem house.

3. Marks

3.1 The rounding marks are inflatable red or white tetrahedron.

The starting mark is an orange flag on a spar buoy or on a RC boat.

The finishing mark is a spar buoy with a blue flag.

3.2 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or move the finishing line) without signalling. This changes RRS 33 and AppS 10.1.

4. Time limits

4.1 Windward-leeward course

The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 15 minutes to sail.

Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 25 minutes.

A boat that does not finish within 10 minutes after the first boat has finished, will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). This changes RRS 35.

4.2 Slalom course (starboard or port)

The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 4 minutes to sail.

Time limit for the first five boats to sail a race is 8 minutes.

Time limit for the first five boats to pass mark 1 is 1 minute (60 seconds) from the starting signal.

The finishing window is 15 minutes.


5. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

5.1 Formula Foil and IQFoil Youth can alternate between windward-leeward course and slalom course. Designated cource area will be displayed on the signal mast- No extra flag = course area D, B flag under flag with letter L= course area B.

5.2 Windward-leeward course


The diagram below shows the course, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side of which each mark is to be left. The course is to be sailed:



(3 laps): Start - 1 - (2a/2b) - 1 - (2a/2b) - 1 - (2a/2b) - Pinend - Finish.

5.3 Slalom course (starboard or port)

The diagram below shows the course, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side of which each mark is to be left. The course is to be sailed (1 laps): Start - 1 - 2 - 3 – Finish.





5.4 The finishing line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel and a blue flag on the course side of the finishing mark.

5.5 The class flag, course area and courses are:

- Class flag All boards **E** when W/L Course, **S** when Slalom

Course

- Starboard or Port Green or Red flag

-3 lap course T

5.6 RRS 26 is changed as follows

Minutes before the start	Visual signal	Sound signal	Means
≥ 5		One	Attention
	Class flag, course flag/-s, U, Black		
3	Flags with numbers 3 2 1	One	Warning signal
2	Flags with numbers 2 1	One	Preparatory signal
1	Flag with number	One long	One minute
0	Flag with number 1 and other flags, except O/R, are removed	One	Starting signal

- 5.7 A boat that does not start within four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.
- 5.8 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat finishes the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later. This change AppS 13.2.
