

Supplementary Sailings Instructions

KSSS Olympic Class Regatta, course area B

Date: 4-5 October 2025

Location: Saltsjöbaden

Classes: Europe Class, 29er, Waszp

Organizer: Royal Swedish Yacht Club

1. Rules

1.1 For the 29er and Waszp classes "Two-Turn Penalty" is changed to "One-Turn Penalty". This changes RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1.

2. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 2.1 The regatta office is located at KSSS Clubhouse in Saltsjöbaden. The Official Noticeboard is the web KSSS Olympic Class Regatta KSSS
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole next to the water close to Sjövillan.
- 2.3 When signal AP is hoisted ashore, replace "1 minute" in RRS with "minimum 60 minutes".
- 2.4 On the water, the race committee communicates with coaches, supporting persons etc on VHF radio channel 72.

3. Time schedule

3.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no start will be made after 15:00

- 3.3 Number of races
 - 5 races are planned for Europe Class.
 - 8 races are planned for 29er and Wazp
- 3.4 Coach meeting with race officer 09:00, outside the Skota Hem house.

4. Marks

4.1 The rounding marks are red marks and red radio-controlled marks

The starting mark is an orange flag on a spar buoy or on a RC boat.

The finishing mark is a spar buoy with a blue flag.

4.2 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or move the finishing line) without signalling. This changes RRS 33 and AppS 10.1.

5. Time limits

- 5.1 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes for Europe Class and 60 minutes for 29er and Waszp.
- 5.2 The finishing window is 15 minutes.
- 5.3 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 40 minutes to sail for Europe Class and 30 minutes for 29er (and Waszp).
- 5.4 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes for Europe Class and 60 minutes for 29er and Wazp.

6. Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

- 6.1 The course for Europe Class
 Outer loop, 2 laps is: Start 1 2 3b 2 3b Finish
- 6.2 The courses for 29er, Wazp Inner loop, 2 laps is: Start 1 4s/4b -1 4b Finish
- 6.3 All marks are to be left to port
- 6.4 The class flags are:
 - a) For 29er a white flag with 29er insignia.
 - b) For Waszp Flag F
 - c) For Europe Class a white flag with Europe Class insignia.
- The Race Committee will not show the course as stated in AppSF 7.1. This changes AppSF 7.1.

6.6 The following start signals will be used, this changes RRS 26, appSF 9.1 and Race Signals "Preparatory Signals":

Before the warning signal the Race Committee will show, which class and which start rule (I, U or Black) that will apply for the coming start. These flags are lowered after each start.




