

Supplementary Sailings Instructions

KSSS Olympic Class Regatta, course area A

Date: 4 – 5 October 2025

Location: Saltsjöbaden

Classes: ILCA 4, ILCA 6 and ILCA 7

Organizer: Royal Swedish Yacht Club

1. Location of the race office and of the flagpole

- 1.1 The regatta office is located at KSSS Clubhouse in Saltsjöbaden. The Official Noticeboard is the web KSSS Olympic Class Regatta KSSS
- 1.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed at flagpole next to the water close to Sjövillan.
- 1.2 When signal AP is hoisted ashore, replace "one minute" in RRS with "earliest 60 minutes".
- 1.3 On the water, the race committee communicates with coaches/supporters etc on VHF radio channel 69.

2. Time schedule

- 2.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no start will be made after 15:00.
- 2.3 Number of races

6 races are planned for ILCA 4 & 7.

6 races are planned for each ILCA 6 sailor.

2.4 Coach meeting with race officer 09:00, outside the Skota Hem house.

3 Marks

3.1 The rounding marks are Yellow/Orange and some will be drone marks.

The starting mark is a drone, boat or buoy with an orange flag.

The finishing mark is between a boat or a boy within blue flag.

3.2 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or move the finishing line) without signalling. This changes RRS 33 and AppSF 10.1.

4 Time limits

- 4.1 Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish is 80 minutes.
- 4.2 Finishing window is 20 minutes.
- 4.3 The race committee will try to set the course so that a race will take approximately 40 minutes to sail.

5 Changes and additions to RRS appendix S

5.1 The courses for ILCA 4 & 6

Course 1 (outer loop) is: Start-1-2-(3s, 3b)-2-3b-Finish Course 2 (inner loop) is: Start-1-(4s,4b)-1-2-3b-Finish

5.2 The courses for ILCA 7

Course 1 (outer loop) is: Start-1-2-(3s, 3b)-2-(3s, 3b)-2-3b-Finish Course 2 (inner loop) is: Start-1-(4s,4b)-1-(4s,4b)-1-2-3b-Finish

- 5.3 Course number will be displayed with a number flag in the pre start sequence.
- 5.4 All marks are to be passed to port, except 3s and 4s which shall be passed to starboard.
- 5.5 The class flags are:

ILCA 4 Yellow flag with ILCA 4 insignia ILCA 6 Green flag with ILCA 6 insignia ILCA 7 White flag with ILCA 7 insignia

- 5.6 The Race Committee will not show the course as stated in AppSF 7.1. This changes AppSF 7.1
- 5.7 The following start signals will be used, this changes RRS 26, appSF 9.1 and Race Signals "Preparatory Signals":

Before the warning signal the Race Committee will show, which class, which group, which course and which start rule (I, U or Black) that will apply for the coming start. These flags are lowered after each start.

5.8 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

6 Race format ILCA 6

6.1 ILCA 6 class will be divided into four groups, Red, Blue, Green and Yellow, by the race committee based on ranking lists of ranked sailors and draw of sailors not on the ranking list using the meander method described below.

6.2 Two groups will sail together in the same race. Six races complete a set as described below:


Race 1	Group Red and Blue

Race 4	Group Blue and Yellow
Race 5	Group Red and Yellow
Race 6	Group Blue and Green
Race 7	Group Red and Blue
Race 8	Group Green and Yellow
Race 9	Group Red and Green
Race 10	Group Blue and Yellow
Race 11	Group Red and Yellow
Race 12	Group Blue and Green

6.3 The race committee may change the starting order of the races.
